Sr. Vice President of Education, American Forest Foundation and National Director, Project Learning Tree

Kathy is past president and a former board member of the North American Association for Environmental Education. She is a frequent speaker and advisor on environmental education issues, including testimony before the Senate on the Environmental Education Act of 1990, and presentations in China, France, Japan, and Mexico. Kathy has received several awards, including the prestigious 1997 Walter E. Jeske Lifetime Achievement Award for Environmental Education from the North American Association for Environmental Education and the Rudolph J. H. Schafer Award from the Western Regional Environmental Education Council in 1989 for her efforts at revitalizing Project Learning Tree and her dedication to environmental education. Kathy will energize our conference by introducing the new *Green Schools!* curriculum and relating stories from other Green Schools across the country.
